Wounded Warrior To Get New Wheelchair

Marine veteran Angel Gomez who was wounded in Iraq, will be getting a new zoom wheelchair thanks to the Southeastern Tulare County Republican Women Federation (SETCO). The club decided on the Track and Zoom wheelchair, which cost \$12,000 and \$15,000, because they are all-terrain and offer more mobility than the average wheelchair. A spokesperson said they started the program because they wanted to give something back to a local wounded warrior.
