I am a home-grown Oregonian who

exception of six months in Georgia while
my dad attended Officer Candidate
School at Fort Benning when I was six.

My daughter, 19 is a sophomore at
Western Oregon University and served as
a member on the Oregon National Guard
Teen Panel. My son, 16 is a sophomore
in high school who plays football and has
other activities.

and we have been together those 26 years
while he has been in the military and

I attended the University of Oregon

RWCL BOOK CLUB REPORT

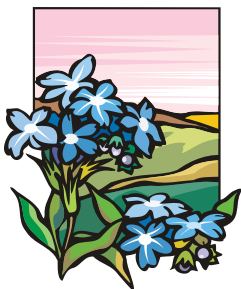
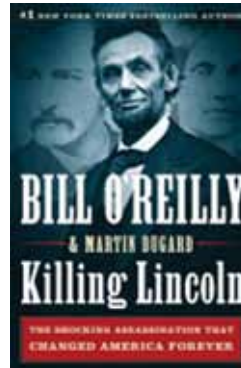
Killing Lincoln by Bill O'Reilly is our new selection for 2013. As you read, You feel like you are right there watching the events.
