Commissioner Leiken was elected to the Lane County Board of Commissioners in November, 2010, and was sworn into office January 3, 2011. His previous civic duties have included serving on the Springfield Budget Committee, Springfield City Council from 1998-2000, and as Springfield Mayor from 2000-2010.

Sid was born in Roseburg, Oregon, where his family owned and operated timber and building development companies. His family eventually moved to Eugene where he graduated from South Eugene High School which makes him a local boy.

Sid and his wife, Debbie were the 2013 chairs of the Lane Community College Foundation Harvest Dinner. 2013 was the most successful year since its inception and they raised almost \$300,000. The Harvest Dinner and auction directly benefits student scholarships and programs.
