



Gordon J. Fulks, Ph.D. is a physicist known recently for his Op-Eds in The Oregonian on Global Warming. One of them titled ***“Global Warming: Climate Orthodoxy Perpetuates a Hoax”*** criticized Governor Kulongoski for forcing State Climatologist George Taylor out of his position at Oregon State

University because he expressed doubts about Anthropogenic Global Warming (AGW).

Dr. Fulks’s background is similar to that of scientists promoting AGW with notable exceptions: he has never accepted ANY money to promote or oppose any theory because that is unethical, and he is considerably more experienced than most who have.

He received a BS in Physics in 1967 and went on to get an MS and Ph.D. in Physics, all from the University of Chicago. He worked in for the Laboratory for Astrophysics and Space Research at the Enrico Fermi Institute of the University of Chicago studying the solar modulation of galactic cosmic rays, using a large charged-particle spectrometer flown in the Arctic.

Dr. Fulks later worked for a think-tank in Santa Barbara, California, supporting the US Defense Nuclear Agency on nuclear weapon effects. When that agency faded away at the end of the Cold War, he supported the Department of State designing new embassies and working at the US Embassy in Moscow. More recently, he has consulted for business

and government clients seeking to better understand electromagnetic phenomena, related scientific scares, and the concept of ‘acceptable risk.’

Dr. Fulks is an avid mountaineer, caver, orchid collector, and tree farmer. He has climbed most major peaks in the Cascades and High Sierras and several major world peaks. He has also explored many caves, including the deepest cave pits in the world, located in central Mexico. He has an extensive orchid collection and grows many trees including 360 Giant Sequoias (which are the largest of all living things and were once native to the Pacific Northwest). ♡

Understanding Our Political Systems

What is a Precinct Committeeperson (PCP)?

Being a PCP is just the beginning of our Oregon political system but it is the foundation. Please check out www.lanegop.org to read all about how Oregon picks their delegates and get informed.

These are men and women who represent the political party in each precinct in a county-wide “Central Committee.” Precinct Committeepersons help set the party agenda and party platform, and are the neighborhood go-to person for political information. They act as directors of the local party Central Committee, attend meetings of the committee, help candidates run for office and conduct business of the party. Central Committee members also elect people to represent the county at the state level, and those members select the representatives to the national committees. They also help select replacements for vacated state offices (Oregon House or Senate Offices).

How Do I Become a PCP?

To qualify as a Precinct Committeeperson (PCP), one must

live in the county and be registered in their political party. The amount of time you must have been registered as a Republican, depends on the method you will become a PCP. A person can represent the precinct in which they live or represent a precinct adjacent to that precinct (within the same county).


They serve a two-year term, and are elected every even-numbered year in May. A Committeeperson of each gender (set by law) is elected in each precinct for every 500 voters (or major part thereof) that is registered in the precinct as of January 31.

Your ballot will indicate how many PCP positions are available in your precinct. For instance, it would say “Vote for Six” if there are six offices available for your precinct. Find on your yellow ballot, the section for your precinct.

Your precinct number is printed on your ballot return envelope. It can also be found above where you sign your name (a 3 or 4 digit number) on the same envelope. Where a candidate is listed, mark your selection like any other race - fill in the oval by their name. If there are openings, or no candidate has filed in your precinct, why not write-in YOUR name?

A write-in candidate must receive at least 3 (three) votes from members of their party within their precinct to be elected. You can vote for yourself and have two other people (family members and neighbors work great) write-in your name on their ballots too - all write-in names for a single person must be spelled the exact same way, or they will not be counted as votes for the same person.

Important Dates & Websites to Check Out

For example, “Bob” Smith and “Robert” Smith will be counted as two different candidates. *Be sure to fill in the oval* in front of your write-in name or it will not be counted. This is VERY important: Be SURE to write your name in the section of your correct gender, or the clerk will not consider you elected even if you have three or more votes.

If you want to write in a name not on the ballot, do so in the box next to “Write-in”, then neatly write the name of the person on the line provided, and fill in the oval in front of the name you write in. We encourage you to write-in only those names of people you know want to serve and who live in your precinct. Don’t “play a joke” on your neighbor by writing their name in, if they don’t want to be a PCP.

After the election, if you are elected as a write-in candidate, you will receive a notice in the mail asking if you accept the election. Please call *Kristy Cooper, Credentials Chair ASAP, at 541-556-8856* so she may compile a list for the June 4th meeting.

You must sign and return the acceptance to the elections office to complete the process in order to actually be elected.

Diana does a monthly newsletter and she posted this for us to get a chuckle from and to show how we are not the only one where the ridiculous is happening. . .

Dog owners living in the Béziers area (of France) will be legally required to have their pet's DNA sample taken by a vet and genetically catalogued. The samples will then be sent by the city to the Bordeaux laboratory Animagène who will then prepare a genetic profile of the animal.

Municipal officials who encounter dog droppings in the street will take a sample and notify the owner who will be fined up to \$500. Owners will have to bear the cost to establish the genetic identity of their dog (about \$40). They will also face an on-the-spot fine of \$45 if they publicly walk a dog that has not been genetically catalogued.
